Aimed at groups of 15 people minimum.

Approximate length, 1 hour.

DISCOVER COBI'S FRIENDS

Activity aimed at pre-school Education.

Aimed at class groups of 25 students approx.

Approximate length, 1 hour and 45 minutes.

This is an interactive tour with an educator of the museum. First, every pupil will have to paint its own identification card with the mascot of the Barcelona'92 Olympic Games, Cobi. After that, a guided tour of the visit will be carried out, where they will look for Cobi's Friends, a Group of mascots of different sport events that will help explaining the most relevant moments and elements of the sports practice in an international level.

REMEMBER THE BARCELONA'92 OLYMPIC GAMES

Activity aimed at all levels from High School .

Aimed at groups between 15 and 20 people.

Approximate length, 2 hours and 15 minutes.

Within the framework of the Barcelona'92 Olympic Games celebration this route on foot, carried out by an educator of the museum, offers to know different spaces of the Olympic Ring where the Olympic Games were hosted. A particular mention to the urbanization of the Montjuïc Mountain is applied. Once the tour is finished, the group will be able to visit the museum.



WALK THROUGH THE OLYMPIC RING

Activity aimed at all levels from High School.

Aimed at groups between 15 and 20 people.

Approximate length, 2 hours and 30 minutes.

The Montjuïc mountain has been always linked to the sports history of the city of Barcelona. Thanks to the International Exhibition of 1929, the Mediterranean Games of 1955, the Olympic Games of 1992 and other events, the mountain has become the epicenter of the sport. In this walk the main areas of the Olympic Ring are covered.



GUIDED TOUR OF THE OLYMPIC STADIUM

Activity aimed at all levels from Elementary Education.

Aimed at groups from 15 people.

Approximate length, 40 minutes.

The guided tour of the Olympic Stadium is a complement to any other type of visit of the museum. From the grades, the most remarkable elements of each venue, their history and the most famous events hosted are explained.

This visit is subject to possible last-minute changes and/or annulations due to the celebration of cultural or sports events inside the venue. It is only available from Tuesdays to Fridays. Any other change will be notified as soon as we receive any notice from the management body.

Once you have finished the visit with us, you have the chance to buy tickets to go to the ground of the Stadium. For more information you can go to the Olympic Stadium Store.



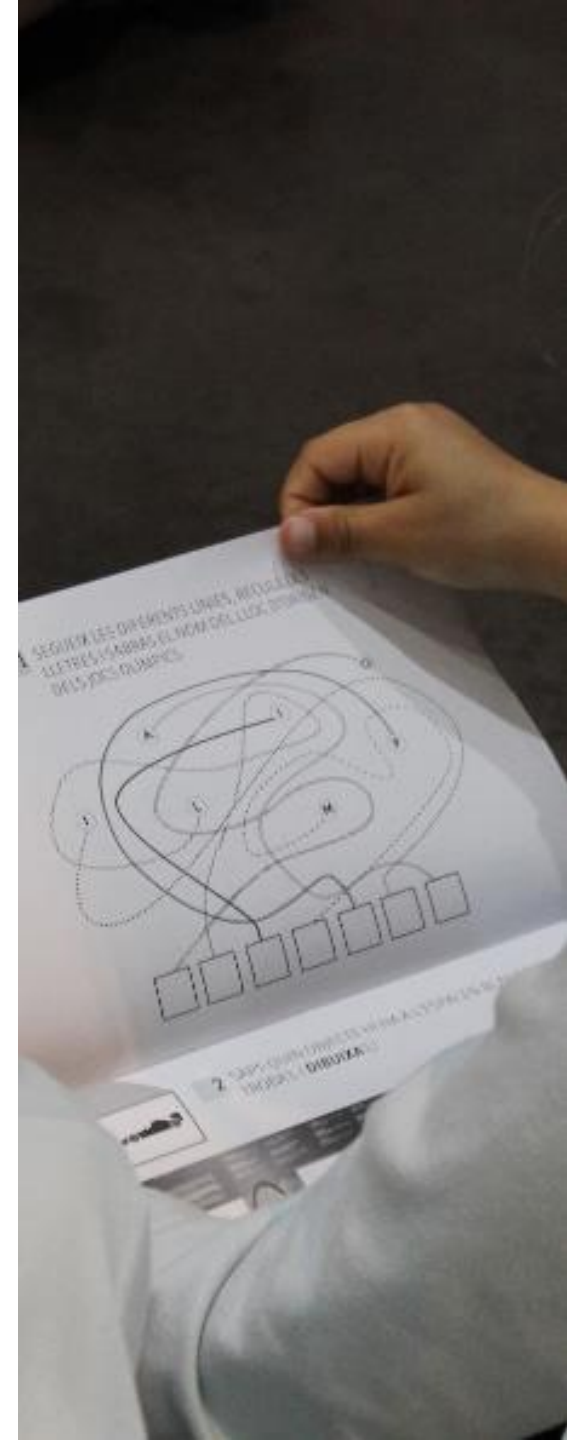
GET READY

Activity aimed at all levels from Elementary Education.

Catalan with 5 levels. Spanish, English and French for students between 12 and 15 years old.

The *Get Ready* is a complementary and self-guided activity, adapted to the different school levels that Will allow the Students a tour of the museum looking for answers to a Group of questions that introduce the world of Olympism, sports practice and the BCN'92 Olympic Games.

A pencil or pen per student is needed. The Get Ready can be asked for in the moment of the reservation and it will be provided in pdf. Before starting the visit, the answer sheet is given to the teachers who can later evaluate the activity.

Some recommendations for you museum visit

Be punctual, specially if you have a guided visit reserved.

In case that people with special needs come, please tell us before the visit.

Teachers and all those accompanying the group must watch for the safety and the control of the group.

On arrival, contact the museum educators in the reception and wait for their indications.

Collaborate with the museum's personnel, specially with regard to the accesses and to the backpacks storage.

The group can gain access to the museum with material to take notes and pictures but it is not allowed to gain access to it with backpacks, bags, food or drink.

Be careful with the exhibited material. Don't run or make noise inside the museum.
